The purpose of a film or television review is to provide an engagingly written and considered response to the work. Please briefly summarise the organisation and content, and contextualise the film. What does the work contribute to the genre? How does the work compare to other films produced by the creator or director? If a work has any shortcomings, be clear and specific. Is this in content or in style? Certainly, feel free to express your personal opinion and reflection of the piece, but please make these observations through a critical assessment which is expressed through insightful commentary. Consider for an academic review that an unenjoyable film may still offer something interesting for an academic to investigate. A good review is both critical and kind.

As you are reviewing a film/television series, please consider such things as performance, special effects, and costume and set design alongside narrative qualities.

The review should be **1000-1500** words. Longer works of **up to 2000** words may be considered if you are reviewing a longer television series. Please check with your editor first. Please use MLA citation if outside sources are included. The title and byline of the review should be as following:

Descriptive Title for your Review
Review by [your name]

Director last name, first name, director. *Title of Work*. Performances by name, name, and name, Producer, date. Film.

If the work is dubbed or has an original language other than English, please include that information in the citation as well. Please also consider any problems of translation that might have occurred. How would meaning change in a new cultural environment, compared to its reception in the country of origin?

Please follow the style guide. It can be found on the Fantastika website, or attached to this email.
