While a non-fiction review should certainly summarise the points and broad strokes of the author's argument, this should also be situated in relation to your own critical reflection. What does the work contribute to the area of study? How does it contribute to existing conversations? Please refrain from making too many generalising summaries and rather provide a nuanced engagement with the material. If a work has any shortcomings, be clear and specific. A good review is both critical and kind.

Review copies, when offered, are provided in good faith. If you are the recipient of a review copy, it is imperative that you are prepared to submit drafts in a timely fashion and work with our editors until they are satisfied that your piece is ready for publication. If the review cannot be completed, it is the reviewer's responsibility to return their review copy to the journal.

The review should be **1500-2000** words. Please use MLA citation if outside sources are included. The title and byline of the review should be as following:

Author last name, first name. *Title of Work*. Publisher, Date. # pp.
